

School Land Trust - Community Council

Each year Canyon View Middle School, along with all other schools in the state, receive funds from the School Land Trust to assist in the operation of the school. How this money is spent is determined by a council made up of parents and school personnel. This council is referred to as the Community Council.

CVMS Community Council is made up of 4 parents and 2 school personnel. The purpose of the council, in addition to overseeing the spending of School Land Trust monies, is to share in the governance of the school. Elections are held each fall to fill any vacancies.

Parents are notified each July by email and/or U.S. mail of vacancies on the council. Parents wishing to be a candidate to serve on this council should contact the principal by the first week of August. If more parents express interest than are positions to fill, an election will be held using Google Forms (each email address in PowerSchool will be sent a ballot) on the Tuesday, prior to the first day of school. Parents may serve a one or two year term. Meetings are held every other month (5 times a year) starting in September.

We feel the council makes a real difference and we hope there are several of you who will lend your support by desiring to serve on the council.
