Getting to Know Canyon View Leaders




Hunter Jones

You have probably heard the word "Math Counts" a lot around Canyon View Middle School lately. That is because Math Counts is a very involved club. A club that some may be afraid to join, but one that will help you with more than just math.

Math Counts meets at least twice each week in Mrs. Sanders' room, D 102. The team usually meets on

Tuesdays and Thursdays so that club members have the opportunity to take the late bus.

Math Counts is open to 6th, 7th, and 8th graders. The team improves their math skills by competing against other middle schools throughout the state.

Canyon View Middle has an awesome team. At the first meet of the year, held in the middle of October, they had 11 individual students place in the

top 9. They competed against Cedar Middle School and Kanab. At this competition, they proved they are a great team taking 5 of the top 9 places!

Math Counts has 2 upcoming competitions. They will compete on November 25 at Cedar Middle School and in Kanab on December 19.
